# Discussion of the Science of Teaching Reading Transition and Test Development Updates

## DISCUSSION

**SUMMARY:** This item provides the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) an update on the Science of Teaching Reading (STR) examination requirement transition and upcoming educator certification test development.

**STATUTORY AUTHORITY:** The statutory authority for the classroom teacher class certificate structure is Texas Education Code (TEC), §§21.003(a), 21.031, and 21.041(b)(1), (2), and (4), 21.041(c), 21.044(a), 21.0441, 21.0418(a).

**FUTURE ACTION EXPECTED:** Texas Education Agency (TEA) staff anticipates presenting an update on educator certification test development to the Board at each SBEC meeting.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION AND JUSTIFICATION:** This item provides an update on the plan to communicate to the field the House Bill (HB) 3, 86<sup>th</sup> Texas Legislature, 2019 requirement that all educators that teach any grade level from prekindergarten through grade six demonstrate proficiency in the science of teaching reading on a certification examination beginning January 1, 2021. In addition, the item provides an update regarding upcoming test development dates. The updated assessments are a part of the teacher certification redesign plan that was discussed with the Board at the August 2018 work session and the October and December 2018 SBEC meetings to improve the quality and consistency of newly certified teachers.

### STR Transition Plan

House Bill (HB) 3, 86th Texas Legislature, 2019, requires that all educators that teach any grade level from prekindergarten through grade six demonstrate proficiency in the science of teaching reading on a certification examination beginning January 1, 2021. TEA staff has provided the Board with regular updates since the July 2019 SBEC work session regarding the STR examination as a part the comprehensive test development timeline.

Since the STR legislative requirement was enacted, TEA staff have actively communicated with the field regarding the associated timelines and requirements for educator preparation programs and teacher candidates. In addition, TEA staff have provided resources to support educator preparation programs in aligning their curriculum for impacted certification fields to the Science of Teaching Reading standards. The certification fields impacted are:

- Core Subjects with Science of Teaching Reading: Early Childhood–Grade 6
- Core Subjects with Science of Teaching Reading: Graces 4–8
- English Language Arts and Reading with Science of Teaching Reading: Grades 4–8, and
- English Language Arts and Reading/Social Studies with Science of Teaching Reading: Grades 4–8

Included in those efforts is a requirement that all EPPs indicate their ability and readiness to successfully prepare candidates for certification in those impacted certification fields. EPPs that choose not to prepare candidates in these fields that require successful completion of the STR exam will be removed from the ability to certify candidates in these areas.

A timeline of TEA staff communication related to the STR transition can be found in Attachment I. Given the COVID-19 disaster, all new communication efforts related to the STR transition have paused and have shifted to provide support and guidance related to the disaster to the field.

An overview of the STR transition communication plan can be found in Attachment II.

## Test Development

Staff is actively working to update the current content pedagogy tests to increase their rigor and relevance and to ensure alignment with the current Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS). A summary of the anticipated first operational dates of the new assessments are in the table below.

The Physical Education (257) assessment has been delayed from a September 1, 2021 operational launch to ensure alignment with the revised TEKS, which are still under development by the State Board of Education (SBOE).
