Schoology includes features and tools to personalize the learning experience and support the diverse student population of Texas.

Teachers can use Schoology to tailor instruction or build a learning sequence specifically for students with individual education plans (IEPs) or 504 plans, English language learners, and students qualifying for gifted services.

Students can move through the content and work at their own pace, and icons visually aid learners as they navigate the site.

Schoology also has features that allow students to complete and respond to discussions in the way they are most comfortable: writing, video, or voice.

Schoology complies with Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act, is compatible with assistive technologies, and does not interfere with accessibility features of other products, operating systems, or browser shortcuts.



Educators can use Schoology to:

- Create assignments for specific students or groups of students
- Provide notes, outlines, and additional learning content
- Record instructions (video/voice)
- Embed voice recordings for assessment questions
- Share data directly with students and set learning goals together
- Embed opportunities for student self-assessment
- Monitor progress and provide students and parents
