These instructions will tell you how to apply for a Probationary certificate, but please be aware that for it to issue after you apply:

- 1. You must pay the certificate and fingerprinting fees
- 2. You must complete the fingerprinting and they must fully process
- 3. Your program, who provided you with these instructions, must recommend you. You will receive a system-generated email once your program has recommended you.
- 4. Once your certificate has issued, you will be notified by email.






