Lessons Learned from TCLAS

LEAs reported that a consolidated grant application process was very useful. But LEAs also reported some challenges with the process.



More time for decision-making and application completion

Announce availability & details earlier

Longer application window

Time the application to coincide with LEA planning cycles



More support and communication to understand and implement opportunities

General and program-specific webinars with details on grant expectations

Office hours for application support

Provide one-on-one support during application to ensure grants are a good fit for LEA

One stop shop [Master Calendar](#) that encompasses all key grant related timelines



Process Improvements in two-step grant application for more user-friendly experience

Add automated data fields to lower the burden on LEAs data input entries

Explore ways to make it a one-step process (unifying program and finance applications)

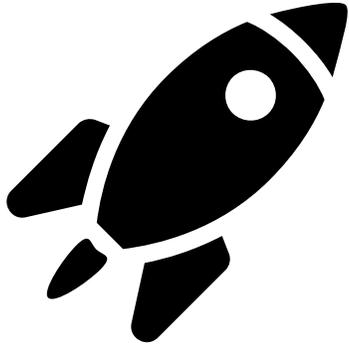

Estimated LASO component grant funding opportunities

Grant Decision	Estimated Total Funding Available	Estimated Range of award	Estimated Number of Awards
Strong Foundations Implementation Supports	~60 Million	In-kind	75-175 LEAs (will vary based on size of LEAs)
Strong Foundations Planning Supports	~15 Million	~ Up to \$400K	50-100 LEAs (will vary based on size of LEA)
Pathway in Technology Early College	~1 Million	~ Up to 100K	10 LEAs
Early College High School	~1 Million	~ Up to 100K	10 LEAs
School Action Fund	~9.5 Million	~ Up to 500K	30 campuses
Tech Lending Grant	~11 Million	~ Up to 225K	50-100 LEAs
Blended Learning Grant	~12 Million	~ Up to 500K	25- 50 LEAs

LASO application window is estimated to be Nov. 7th - Dec. 22nd



Estimated Application Window

November 7, 2022- December 22, 2022

We recognize that this window runs up against the winter break in some cases. Our intent here is to provide as much time and a longer runway to application completion as possible.

We intent to work with LEAs alongside ESCs to provide the supports needed to be set up for success to apply and complete the application
