You can still apply for Pandemic Electronic Benefit Twhich helps families get the food they need during pandemic by providing a one-time benefit of \$285 pe child. The application has been extended until August 21

You will have one year from the date the benefits were issued to use your P-EBT benefits. F benefits are non-transferrable. Immigration status and the public charge rule will not affect when applying for benefits.

Who Needs to Apply?

Children who have been approved for free or reduced-price school meals or attend a school that offered free meals to all students through the National School Lunch Program can receive PEBT benefits.

Eligible families that DID NOT receive SNAP benefits for the month of March 2020 must apply for PEBT.

- If you do not currently get SNAP benefits and your child is approved for P-EBT, you will be mailed a P-EBT card loaded with benefits.


- You do not need to apply for children ages 5-18 as of May 17, 2020. Benefits were loaded onto your existing Lone Star Card by May 22.
- If you have eligible children under 5 and/or between the ages of 19 and 21, you will need to fill out an application if those children meet the criteria below.
 - All children, no matter the age, must have been approved for free or reduced-price school meals or attend a school that offered free meals to all students through the National School Lunch Program.

 - Including your child's school ID# (also called Local ID) and Social Security number when applying will help to determine if your child is eligible.

 - If you are approved, funds will be loaded on to your current Lone Star Card.

If you applied for benefits and think your child was denied in error, contact us within 15 days of receiving your denial notice to provide proof of eligibility. Proof includes the award letter that is sent to parents when their children become eligible for the National School Lunch Program.
