HIGH-IMPACT TUTORING TRAINING

Intervene K-12 has been recruiting and training tutors since 2015. Intervene K-12 has built a dedicated staffing and vetting program for recruiting, training, and onboarding tutors at scale.

Intervene K-12 tutors are given an initial assessment to determine approproate placement based on their knowledge. Once placed, tutors are provided extensive training on state standards, content, and proper tutoring etiquitte.

Tutor Managers are responsible for ensuring tutors have materials, are online, provide technology support, and coach tutors in instruction.

Auditors provide another layer of Tutorial Quality Controls. They monitor tutor interactions and measure outcomes. Auditors make recommendations for additional Tutor training and also remove ineffective tutors.

HIGH QUALITY INSTRUCTION MATERIALS

-All students are provided a pre-assessment to gather baseline data on areas of academic need. -Intervene's instructional materials utilize the gradual release model which allows the responsibility of learning to slowly move from the teacher modeling to joint responsibility of learning between teacher and students to students engaging in independent practice (Pearson & Gallagher, 1983).

-All lessons are aligned to state standards and include grade-level content, which benefits all populations and accelerates learning–especially important with COVID learning loss.

-Each lesson has a specific learning goal with activities to work towards said goal

-Formative assessments are included in the form of exit tickets to demonstrate academic understanding or areas to revisit for re-teach.

-Progress monitoring is provided via aligned assessments.

-Teachers can run student group reports, which provide specific strategies for Tier 1 and Tier 2 instruction, based on students' assessment performance.

-Campus and district leaders can also run reports at a higher level to establish focused PLCs within the core content areas based on students' assessment performance.
