

Title I, 1003 School Improvement Grant: General Info and Updates





WHAT: Non-competitive school improvement grant

►<u>WHO</u>:

For LEAs with at least one Title I, Part A-served Comprehensive Support and Improvement identified campus
 Must have been awarded the Title I School Improvement Grant in previous school year

WHEN: eGrants applications will open on September 13th





Title I, 1003 School Improvement Grant Cont.

➤ <u>Stipulations</u>:

LEAs must submit a commitment to interventions and supports by July 23rd, 2021*

Funding:

Each campus that submits their commitment will receive \$14,285
 LEA may then also retain unused funds from previous grant year

➢<u>Requirements</u>:

Engage in the Effective Schools Framework process through Plan4Learning portal

- Self-assessments
- Diagnostics as needed
- > Targeted Improvement Plan (TIP)

 Conduct Needs Assessment

>Attend all required trainings







- Technology, training, PLC focus, etc.







Title I, 1003 Takeaways & Reminders

≻<u>Remember</u>:

➤ Eligibility...

Only LEAs who participated in last year's SIG and who identify at least 1 Title Iserved Comprehensive Support and Improvement campus are eligible for the 2021-2022 \$10k/campus award. These LEAs are also the only ones permitted to use carry-over funds from 2020-2021.

➤ Timeline...

- > Grant application opens Sept. 13th
- > Grant application closes Nov. 12th
- > Initial Budget Submission due Oct. 1st
- Final award amount Dec. 17th (includes carry over)
- > Mid cycle check March 4th
- > Grant cycle ends Sept. 2022
