The Texas Education Agency (TEA) is pleased to announce that the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2023 Part B State Annual Performance Report (APR) for the 2023–24 school year, along with the 2025 State special education Determination for the FFY 2023 State Performance Plan/Annual Performance Report (SPP/APR), are now available for public viewing on the [TEA website](http://tea.texas.gov).

State Annual Performance Report

The Annual Performance Report (APR) was submitted to the Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) at the U.S. Department of Education on February 3, 2025. The APR provides OSEP with information on the state's compliance and performance under the State Performance Plan (SPP) for implementing the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

TEA is required to publish the APR on its website, making it available to both the public and the media. This requirement is based on federal regulation [34 CFR §300.602\(b\)\(1\)\(i\)\(B\)](#), which mandates public reporting of the SPP/APR through public means, including posting on the state educational agency website and distribution to the media. It is also supported by the implementing statute [20 U.S.C. §1416\(b\)\(2\)\(C\)](#), and federal guidance from OSEP, specifically [QA 23-01](#).

State Annual Determination

The OSEP issued the 2025 IDEA, Part B, Determination for Texas on June 20, 2025, for the FFY 2023 SPP/APR submission and determined that Texas “Meets Requirements.” This determination means that Texas is meeting the requirements and purposes of IDEA. The determination letter is available on page 141 of the FFY 2023 SPP/APR submission.
