This report contains the number and percentage of candidates who received initial, standard teaching certificates through each preparation route in the last five academic years aggregated by gender and race / ethnicity. In several academic year, the sum of each race / ethnicity does not equal the total. This is because a few teachers did not report their race / ethnicity.

**Definitions:** An initial teaching certificate is a standard teaching certificate issued to a teacher who was not previously issued a standard or lifetime teaching certificate. Standard certificates, as defined in 19 TAC Chapter 230, are certificates offered since September 1, 1999 that are renewed every five years. The academic year is determined by the date of issuance. An academic year is defined as September 1 through August 31 of the following calendar year. Educators self-identify their gender and race / ethnicity in the Educator Certification Online System (ECOS). Educators may identify their gender as Male or Female. The race / ethnicity categories included in the table are mutually exclusive and educators can update their race / ethnicity specification at any time. In some instances, gender or race / ethnicity is not reported by the individual or local education agency.
