




House Bill 2607 Requires Partnership Data Reporting

- ➤ The Texas Workforce Commission must assess the number of 3-star and 4-star rated child care providers participating in partnerships with public school districts and public charter schools based on data provided by TEA
 - ➤ LEAs will report the Child Care Operation Number for <u>ALL</u> child care providers that are participating in a partnership where students are dually enrolled





What are Public-Private PreK Partnerships?

Prekindergarten partnerships are collaborations between local education agencies (LEAs) and private early learning programs (ELPs) or Head Start programs.

Formal

- Partners dually enroll children to provide prekindergarten and/or additional wrap-around services
- LEA passes through state funding to the ELP

Informal


- Partners share resources and information across LEA and ELP
- Students are not dually enrolled
- No funding is passed through
- Only information on formal partnerships should be reported in ECDS.
- As PreK partnerships grow throughout the state, TEA and Texas Workforce Commission need quality data about where they are happening to gauge success and inform future strategies for agencies and districts.



TEM PK School Types for PreK partnerships are reported in ECDS

PK School Type

- Designates the type of PreK program provided at the school
- Entered at the "section" level (i.e., classroom)
- Included in the InterchangeMasterSchedule.xml file





TEA ECDS: PK School Type

- The current PK School Types have been more clearly defined to support LEAs in reporting accurate data to the ECDS
- Types 07, 08 and 11 can be types of partnership classrooms

PK School Type Code	Definition
02 Public Pre-K	Would be reported for public school programs implementing prekindergarten programs (excluding partnerships)
07 Public Pre-K Head Start	Would be reported for public prekindergarten programs that partner with a Head Start program (includes LEA/Head Start partnership classrooms and LEA grantee Head Start classrooms)
08 Public Pre-K Licensed Child Care	Would be reported for public prekindergarten programs that partner directly with a licensed child care provider to dually enroll students (includes partnership classrooms where children are dually enrolled in both the LEA and child care provider site).
11 In-District Charter Partnership	Would be reported for prekindergarten programs that are operated through an in-district charter partnership. The board of the LEA has authorized a non-profit organization, government entity, institute of higher education, and/or an existing charter school as an indistrict charter.


Note: There are other PK School Types for private entities not associated with a school district.



Child Care Operation Numbers for Prek partnerships are reported in ECDS

Child Care Operation Number

- Required field if PreK School Type code selected is a partnership
- Designates the child care center(s) partnered with the school district
- Entered at the LEA level
- Included in the InterchangeEducationOrganizationExtension.xml file





ECDS: Child Care Operation Number

- If PK School Type 07, 08 or 11 is selected, the Child Care Operation Number will be a mandatory field
- A Child Care Operation Number is a unique identifier for each licensed child care in the state, assigned by Child Care Regulation
- It is an 8-digit field
 - Numbers after the dash can be dropped (they signify that the child care is part of a chain)
 - If the number is less than 8-digits, pad it with zeros
 - For example, 171701 → 00171701
 - Head Start classrooms without operation numbers may leave the field blank



Helpful tip:

While you should confirm accuracy with the child care partner, child care operation numbers are public information and can be found at Child Care Regulation's Search Texas Child Care webpage.



Examples for ECDS Reporting

- Scenario 1 LEA partners with a private child care provider
 - Type 08 Public Pre-K Licensed Child Care
 - LEA will report the operation number
- Scenario 2 LEA partners with several different private child care providers
 - Type 08 Public Pre-K Licensed Child Care
 - LEA will report several operation numbers
- Scenario 3 LEA is a Head Start provider
 - Type 07 Public Pre-K Head Start
 - LEA may report or may leave the operation number field blank if there is no operation number
- Scenario 4 LEA partners with a Head Start provider that has an operation number
 - Type 07 Public Pre-K Head Start
 - LEA will report the operation number
- Scenario 5 LEA partners with a Head Start provider that does not have an operation number
 - Type 07 Public Pre-K Head Start
 - LEA may leave the operation number field blank
