Mentor & Induction Training (100 possible points)

All applications will be reviewed based on the extent to which they meet the requirements below.

Training Alignment to MPA Requirements (40 points)

To what extent is the provider's mentor and induction training program aligned to MPA requirements?

- The applicant describes a solid research or evidence base for both the content and the delivery of the mentor and induction training program (Section E).
- Clear alignment exists between the training's research or evidence base (Section E) and the scope and sequence (Attachment D).
- > The scope and sequence (Attachment D) includes all five training topics listed in the application:
 - o effective mentoring partnerships
 - coaching cycles
 - o data-driven instruction
 - o lesson planning
 - o learning environment
- The scope and sequence demonstrates how the training will effectively develop the mentor teachers' knowledge, skills, and mindsets related to the best mentorship practices listed in the application (see the list in Section D). Explicit alignment to training provided on these best practices is clearly evident in the scope and sequence.
- > The scope and sequence provides training before the school year starts and at least once per semester (Attachment D). The applicant must include seasons or months in the scope and sequence; exact dates are not required.
- The scope and sequence indicates that the mentor teachers, campus administrators, and other staff who support beginning teachers will attend the training (Attachment D).

Experience with Mentor & Induction Training (25 points)
