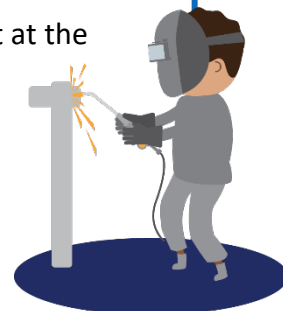

SPPI 14B Calculation Example

| Respondent youth who are no longer in secondary school and had IEPs in effect at the time they left school | # |
|--|--------------|
| a. enrolled in higher education within one year of leaving high school | 1,000 |
| b. competitively employed within one year of leaving high school | 1,500 |
| c. enrolled in some other post-secondary education or training program within one year of leaving high school (but not enrolled in higher education or competitively employed) | 200 |
| d. in some other employment within one year of leaving high school (but not enrolled in higher education, some other post-secondary education or training program, or competitively employed) | 400 |
| e. Total respondent youth who are no longer in secondary school and had IEPs in effect at the time they left school (a + b + c + d) | 4,000 |

Enrolled in Higher Education or Competitively Employed Calculation

$$\begin{aligned}
 \text{Percentage} &= [(a + b) / e] \times 100 \\
 &= [(1,000 + 1,500 / 4,000)] \times 100 \\
 &= (2,500 / 4,000) \times 100 \\
 &= .63 \times 100 \\
 &= 63\%
 \end{aligned}$$
