SPPI 6B Calculation Example

Educational Environments	#
a. Attending a regular early childhood program and receiving a majority of special education and related services in the regular early childhood program	39
b. Attending a special education program (not in any regular early childhood program) in a separate special education class, separate school, or residential facility	15
c. Receiving special education and related services in the home (not in a regular early childhood program)	3
d. Attending a regular early childhood program and receiving a majority of special education and related services in some other location	21
e. Attending neither the regular early childhood program nor special education program, and receiving the majority of special education and related services in the service provider location	10

Attending a Separate Special Education Class, Separate School, or Residential Facility Calculation

$$\begin{aligned}
 \text{Percentage} &= [b / (a + b + c + d + e)] \times 100 \\
 &= [15 / (39 + 15 + 3 + 21 + 10)] \times 100 \\
 &= (15 / 88) \times 100 \\
 &= .17 \times 100 \\
 &= 17\%
 \end{aligned}$$
