As required by Texas Education Code (TEC) §37.115(k), local education agencies (LEA), which include school districts and open enrollment charter schools, are required to report the annual activities of Safe and Supportive School Program (SSSP) teams to the Texas Education Agency (TEA). This instrument is the method that is currently being used by the TEA to collect the required data.
