

SSSP Data Collection Questions for 2022-2023 School Year

As required by Texas Education Code §37.115(k), Safe and Supportive School Program (SSSP) teams are required to report their annual activities by campus to the Texas Education Agency (TEA). This instrument is the method that is currently being used by the TEA to collect the required data for each campus. SSSP teams are responsible for following the policies and procedures established by their LEA for collecting and maintaining documentation of reported threats, threat assessments conducted, and outcomes of each threat assessment for each campus served by the team.

Data Regarding Threat Reports

SSSP teams are required to report both the number and type of threats reported through their locally developed reporting mechanism. Threat reports include those reports screened by the team but not referred for threat assessment.

Data Regarding Behavioral Threat Assessment Outcomes

SSSP teams are required to report the outcome by type for each threat assessment conducted by the SSSP team. Data regarding threat assessments that resulted in disciplinary placement are not included in this collection as they are reported through the Texas Student Data System (TSDS) Public Education Information Management System (PEIMS) data collection.
