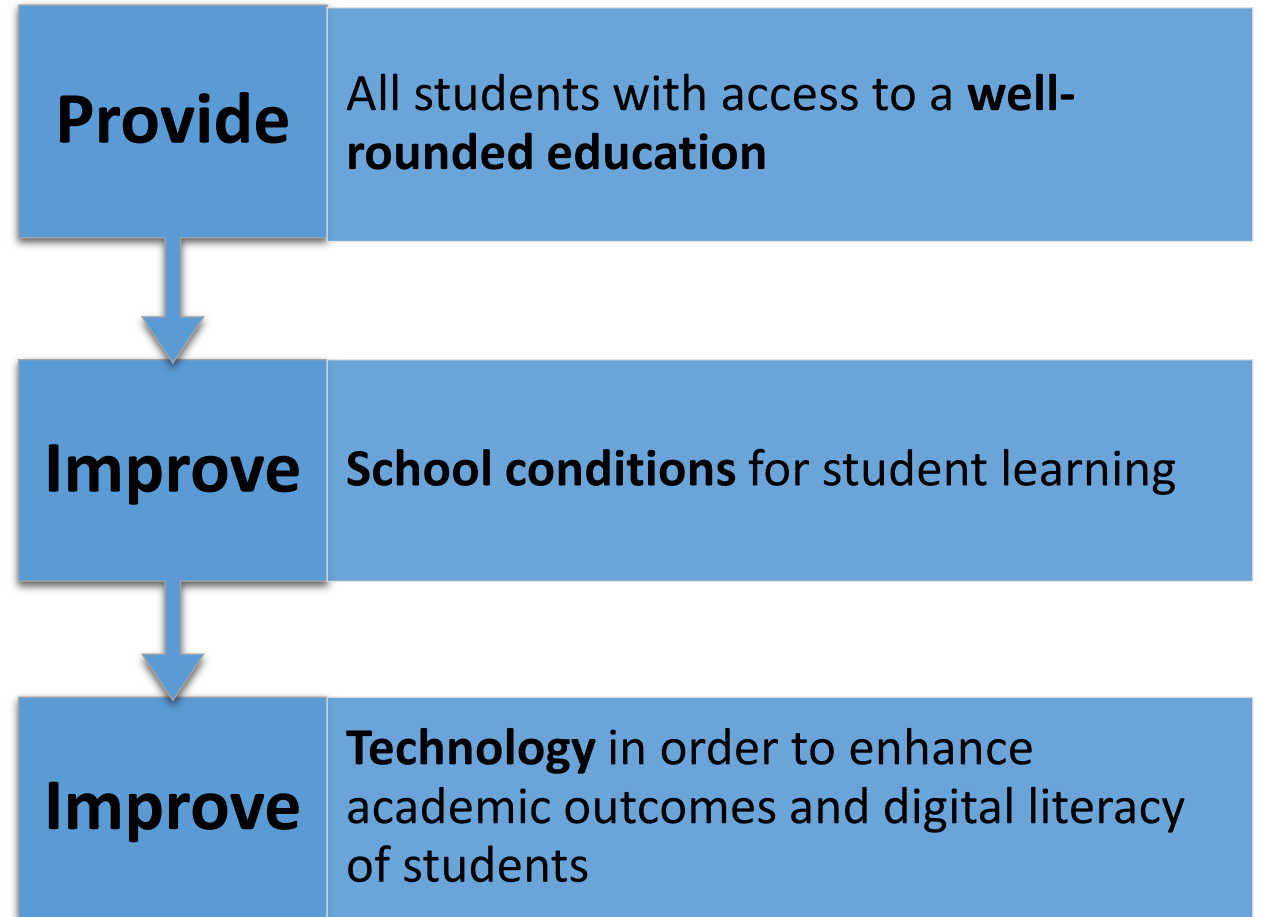

# Importance of Public Reporting
