Purple Star Campus Designation – School Year (SY) 2022-2023

The Purple Star Campus Designation is a special honor created by the 86th Texas Legislature through Senate Bill (SB) 1557 that recognizes campuses of Texas school districts and open-enrollment charter schools that show their support and commitment to meeting the unique needs of military-connected students and their families.

For the 2022-2023 school year, the Texas Education Agency (TEA) will award the Purple Star Campus Designation for campuses that apply and meet the established criteria. **Applications will be accepted from Tuesday, April 5, 2022, through Wednesday, June 1, 2022.** For more information on the application process, established criteria, and timelines please visit <u>TEA's Purple Star Campus</u> <u>Designation</u>. Schools that are selected will receive a virtual Purple Star recognition to display on campus or on the school website. Notifications of award outcomes will be announced by the TEA in August 2022. All campuses receiving the designation will also be featured on the <u>TxSchools.gov</u> webpage.

Please note: Designations last for two school years.
