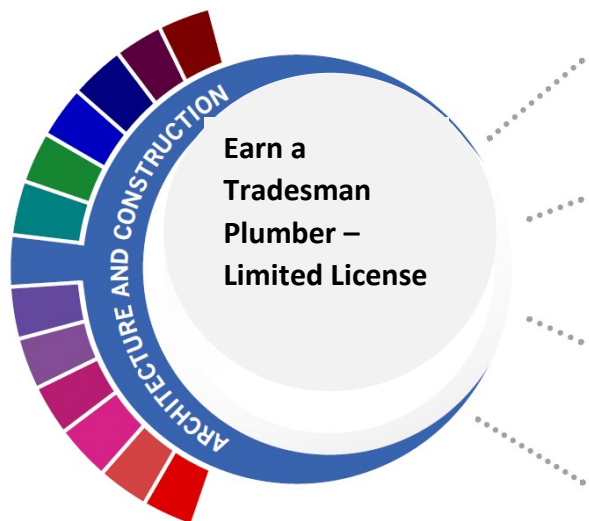


A student can earn a Tradesman Plumber – Limited License and go straight to work after high school graduation and/or continue higher education.

### TYPE OF WORK A TRADESMAN PLUMBER-LIMITED LICENSE HOLDER CAN DO

A Tradesman Plumber Limited licensee is able to install and repair water, gas, and other piping systems in homes. They can install plumbing fixtures, such as bathtubs and toilets, and appliances, such as dishwashers and water heaters. They can clean drains, remove obstructions, and repair or replace broken pipes and fixtures.

In addition, as a plumber progresses through the licensing ranks the plumber may also learn and develop an interest in more specialized plumbing such as the installation of medical gas piping and residential fire sprinkler system installations at the Journeyman and Master license levels. Both of these license levels require additional training and an examination to obtain the applicable endorsement on the Journeyman and/or Master license.
