College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) Verifier Now Available Texas Education Agency sent this bulletin on 05/24/2023

To the Superintendent Addressed:

The College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) Verifier is now available on the Performance Reporting tab within the TEA Login (TEAL) Accountability application. Districts should use the CCMR Verifier to verify the accuracy of their CCMR data which will be included in 2023 accountability ratings and, if needed, submit official documentation to correct data by June 21, 2023. If no discrepancies are found, no action is required.

Eligible for corrections and shown on the verifier:

- ACT college admissions test
- AP examination
- IB examinations
- TSI assessment
- SAT college admissions test
- OnRamps dual enrollment course completion
- Level I and Level II certificates*

*do not submit industry-based certification documentation through the level I and level II certificates field

Not eligible for corrections (TSDS PEIMS) and not shown on the verifier:

- Graduate with completed IEP and workforce readiness
- Graduate with Advanced Diploma Plan and current special education student
- College Prep course completion
- Dual Credit course completion
- Industry-Based certification
- Associate degree

CCMR data is shown for 2021–22 annual graduates and non-graduating 12th graders. Minimum requirements for credit can be found in the **CCMR Verifier Data Requirements**.
