Subject: Notification of Correction of Noncompliance

Dear Dr. Jason Hewitt:

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Shepherd Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the Cyclical Review.

Shepherd ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 1/31/2024 listing the following areas of noncompliance:

- IEP Development: Measurable Annual Goals
34 CFR §300.320 (a)(2)(i); 19 TAC §89.1055 (b)
- Transition: Postsecondary Goals
19 TAC § 89.1055 (j)(1); 34 CFR § 300.320(b)(1)
- Transition: Notice of Transfer of Rights
19 TAC § 89.1049(a); TEC § 29.017(c)

The corrective action plan addressed identified noncompliance. The local education agency (LEA) submitted documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) demonstrating the noncompliance has been corrected. Based on this evidence, the issue is considered resolved, and no further action is required at this time.
