Subject: Notification of Correction of Uncorrected Noncompliance

Dear Edward Conger:

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the International Leadership of Texas (Iltexas) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the Cyclical Desk Review.

A notification of uncorrected noncompliance identified in the 2024-2025 Cyclical Desk Review was sent on 1/30/2026. The notification of uncorrected noncompliance detailed the specific areas of noncompliance:

- State Assessment: Intensive Plan of Instruction
34 CFR §300.160(c); §300.320(a)(6); 19 TAC §89.1055(b)
- Transition: Function Vocational Evaluation
TAC § 89.1055(k)(4); TEC § 29.011(a)(5)
- Transition: Consideration of a referral to a governmental agency
19 TAC § 89.1055(k)(5); TEC § 29.011(a)(9)
- Transition: If appropriate, invitation of a participating agency
34 CFR § 300.321(b)(3); TAC § 89.1050(c)(1)(H)

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The corrective action plan addressed the identified noncompliance. The local education agency (LEA) submitted documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) by 4/30/2026 demonstrating that the noncompliance has been corrected. Based on this evidence, the issue is considered resolved, and no further action is required at this time.
