The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Irving Independent School District of the correction of noncompliance identified in the Targeted Review.

Irving ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 7/24/2025, listing the following areas of noncompliance:

- Properly Constituted ARD: Written Excusals
34 CFR §300.321(e)(2); 34 CFR §300.321(a)(2)-(a)(5)
- IEP Development: Development of Present Levels of Academic Achievement and Functional Performance (PLAAFP)
34 CFR §300.320(a)(1)
- IEP Development: Measurable Annual Goals
34 CFR §300.320 (a)(2)(i); 19 TAC §89.1055 (b)

The corrective action plan addressed identified noncompliance. The local education agency (LEA) submitted documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) demonstrating the noncompliance has been corrected. Based on this evidence, the issue is considered resolved, and no further action is required at this time.
