Subject: Notification of Correction of Noncompliance

Dear Dr. Keeley Boyer:

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Ector County Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the **Cyclical Desk Review**.

Ector County ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 7/24/2025 listing the following areas of noncompliance:
