Subject: Notification of Correction of Noncompliance

Dear Dr. Joe Lopez:

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Greenville Independent School District of the correction of noncompliance identified in the Targeted Review.

Greenville ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 7/24/2025 listing the following areas of noncompliance:

- IEP Development: Development of Present Levels of Academic Achievement and Functional Performance (PLAAFP)
34 CFR §300.320(a)(1)
- IEP Development: Measurable Annual Goals
34 CFR §300.320 (a)(2)(i); 19 TAC §89.1055 (b)
- State Assessment: Intensive Program of Instruction/Accelerated Instruction Plan
TEC §28.0211(i)

The corrective action plan addressed identified noncompliance. The local education agency (LEA) submitted documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) demonstrating the noncompliance has been corrected. Based on this evidence, the issue is considered resolved, and no further action is required at this time.
