Subject: Notification of Correction of Noncompliance

Dear Mr. Brent Jaco:

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Pecos-Barstow-Toyah Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the **Targeted Review**.

Pecos-Barstow-Toyah ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 7/26/2024 listing the following area of noncompliance:

- IEP Development: Measurable Goals
34 CFR §300.320(a)(2)(i)

A plan for correction of the noncompliance was included in your corrective action plan. Subsequently, the local education agency (LEA) was required to submit documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) verifying correction for the abovementioned noncompliance. The documentation submitted by the LEA indicated that this area of noncompliance has been addressed, and the noncompliance has been corrected.
