Subject: Notification of Correction of Noncompliance

Dear Mr. Oscar Aguero,

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Schleicher Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the **Cyclical Desk Review**.

Schleicher ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 1/31/2025 listing the following areas of noncompliance:
