

# Navigating Performance Reporting Resources: Connecting Knowledge to School Improvement and Turnaround Plan Requirements

## APPLYING RESOURCES AND KNOWLEDGE ACROSS THE AGENCY

The count of consecutive unacceptable performance ratings determines the Turnaround Plan (TAP) requirements. To determine a campus' intervention requirements for Turnaround Plans (TAP), you first need to understand how the consecutive count of unacceptable ratings determines the Turnaround Plan requirements and current state.

## TURNAROUND PLAN REQUIREMENTS BASED ON SUBCHAPTER C. CAMPUS TURNAROUND PLAN OF CHAPTER 39A

### Unacceptable Count

If a campus has been identified as unacceptable for two consecutive school years, the commissioner shall order the campus to prepare and submit a turnaround plan (Count of 2 initiates the development of a TAP).

A turnaround plan must take effect following the third consecutive school year that the campus has received an unacceptable performance rating (Count of 3 initiates the requirement to implement a TAP).

If a campus earns five consecutive unacceptable performance ratings, the commissioner shall order an appointment of a board of managers or closure of the campus (Count of 5).

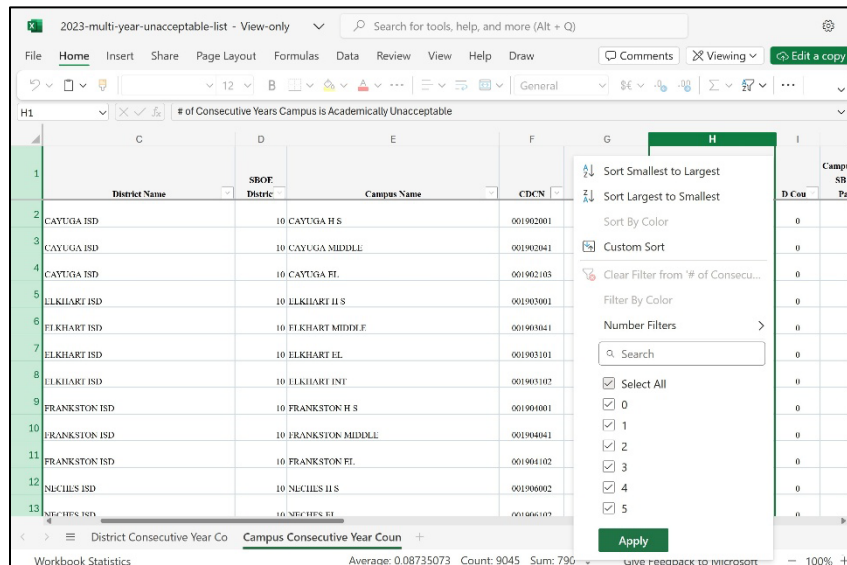

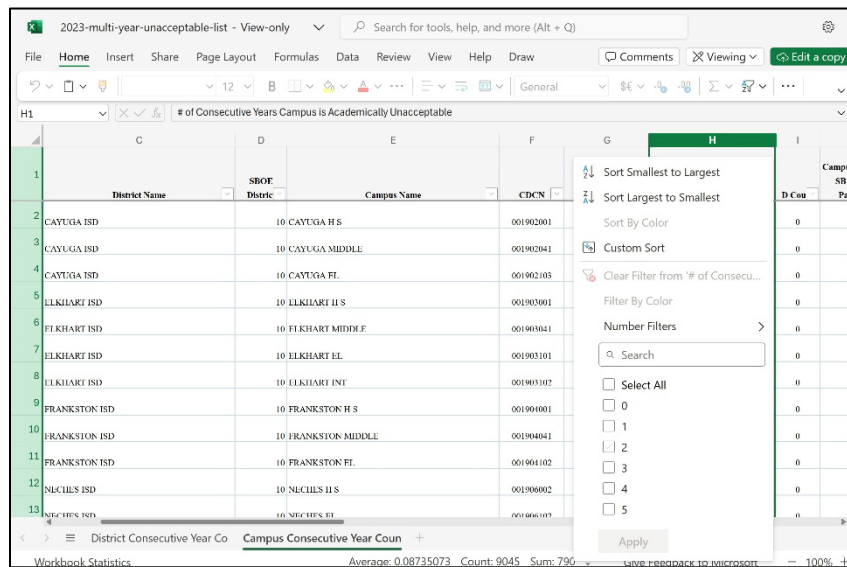
