

# Reporting Student Data File Format

### **Overview**

Following is a list of the most significant changes being implemented in the 2025 STAAR Alternate 2 3-8 Student Data File Format.

- 1. **GRADE LEVEL TESTED** Field was previously Grade-Level-Code (Position 5).
- 2. TITLE-I-PART-A-INDICATOR-CODE New value of A added (Position 101).
- **3. ENROLLED GRADE** Field added (Position 141).
- **4. ITEM REPORTING CATEGORY NUMBERS** These fields have been added for all subjects (Positions 451, 801, 1601, 2001).
- 5. ITEM STUDENT RESPONSES These fields have been added for all subjects (Positions 503, 857, 1653, 2055).
- **6. PREVIOUS YEAR READING LANGUAGE ARTS FIELDS** These fields have been replaced with blanks (Positions 430-444 & 2553-2554).
- **7. PREVIOUS YEAR MATHEMATICS FIELDS** These fields have been replaced with blanks (Positions 783-797 & 2673-2674).

**NOTE:** The data will be provided in a fixed-length text file format (no header) in the layout defined.
