

Overview

- 1. **TITLE-I-PART-A-INDICATOR-CODE** New value of A added (Position 101).
- 2. ITEM REPORTING CATEGORY NUMBERS Field added (Position 431).
- 3. **ITEM STUDENT RESPONSES** Field added (Position 499).

NOTE: The data will be provided in a fixed-length text file format (no header) in the layout defined.
