- 1. Ethnicity/Race Reporting Category— Field name changed from 'Race/Ethnicity-Code' (Position 113).
- 2. Title-I-Part-A-Indicator-Code Value of 'A' added (Position 115).
- 3. **Result ID** New field added which replaced Opportunity Key (Position 171-206).
