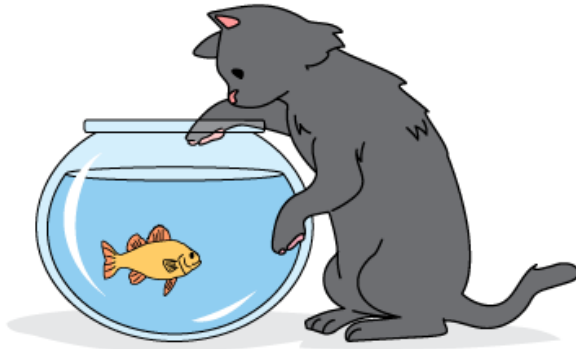
### 1.1

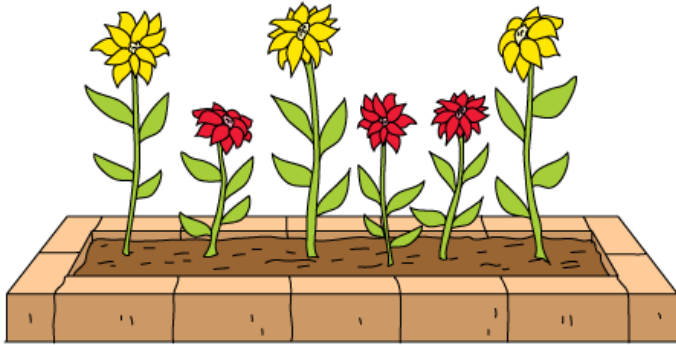
## 1.2

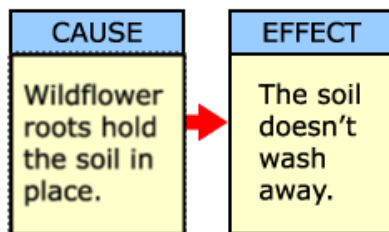
