

Reporting Student Data File Format

Overview

Following is a list of the most significant changes being implemented in the 2023 STAAR 3-8 Student Data File Format.

- 1. ADMINISTRATION DATE Updated to reflect current test administration period of Spring 2023. (Position 1)
- 2. FALL 2022 TSDS PEIMS HOMELESS-STATUS-CODE New field from the PEIMS database. (Position 110)
- 3. **SECTION 504-INDICATOR-CODE** New field added in TIDE. (Position 112)
- 4. FALL 2022 TSDS PEIMS STUDENT-LANGUAGE-CODE New field from PEIMS database. (Position 153)
- 5. **AGENCY USE** * is no longer an acceptable value as there are no scanned paper tests. (Positions 221-230, 236-245)
- 6. **SPEECH-TO-TEXT** Accommodation added for constructed response items in Reading Language Arts, Social Studies and Science. Replaces Designated Supports field. (Positions 252, 312, and 332)
- 7. **NON-EMBEDDED DESIGNATED SUPPORTS** This field replaces "Oral Administration" and has new acceptable values. *Oral Administration is no longer collected at the state level.* (Positions 255, 275, 315, and 335)
- 8. **SPELLING ASSISTANCE** Accommodation added for constructed response items in Reading Language Arts, Social Studies and Science. (Positions 261, 321 and 341)
- 9. **SCORE CODE** * is no longer an acceptable value since there are no scanned paper tests. (Positions 351, 352, 354 and 355)
- 10. **SCORE CODE DEFAULT** 1 no longer indicates multiple gridded values since there are no scanned paper tests. (Positions 356, 357, 359 and 360)
- 11. **PERFORMANCE LEVEL INDICATOR** New field in Reading Language Arts and Mathematics to indicate student's growth from the previous year. In Reading Language Arts, this field replaces Reporting Category 3 scores. (Positions 405 and 759)
- 12. **STAAR PROGRESS MEASURE** STAAR Progress Measure will not be reported in 2023. Related fields in Reading Language Arts and Mathematics have been replaced with blanks. (Positions 426-444 and 780-797)
- 13. **ITEM STUDENT RESPONSES** –New acceptable values for non multiple-choice items. (Positions 503, 857, 1653 and 2055)
- 14. **EXTENDED CONSTRUCTED RESPONSE SCORE** New field for the embedded Extended Constructed Response item on the Reading Language Arts test. (Position 615)
- 15. **POINTS POSSIBLE** Field added to indicate the number of points possible for each item from 0-2. (Positions 1018, 1103, 1760, and 2446)
- 16. **POINTS ACHIEVED** Field added to indicate the number of points achieved for each item from 0-2. (Positions 1058, 1148, 1817, and 2488)
- 17. **PRIMARY ADMINISTRATION FIELDS READING LANGUAGE ARTS** Fields have been replaced with Points Achieved Science and blanks as there are no longer two administrations. (Positions 2501-2530)
- 18. **PRIMARY ADMINISTRATION FIELDS MATHEMATICS** Fields have been replaced with blanks as there are no longer two administrations. (Positions 2561-2650)
- 19. **PREVIOUS YEAR WRITING HISTORY SPRING ADMINISTRATION** Fields have been replaced with blanks. (Positions 2741-2764)
- 20. **DISCREPANCY INDICATOR** Type 1 Discrepancy has been removed as there are no scanned paper tests. (Positions 3371-3374)
