SPPI 14C Calculation Example

Respondent youth who are no longer in secondary school and had IEPs in effect at	
the time they left school	#
a. enrolled in higher education within one year of leaving high school	1,000
b. competitively employed within one year of leaving high school	1,500
c. enrolled in some other post-secondary education or training program within	
one year of leaving high school (but not enrolled in higher education or	
competitively employed)	200
d. in some other employment within one year of leaving high school (but not	
enrolled in higher education, some other post-secondary education or training	
program, or competitively employed)	400
e. Total respondent youth who are no longer in secondary school and had IEPs	
in effect at the time they left school (a + b + c + d)	4,000

Enrolled in Higher Education, Some Other Post-Secondary Education, or Training Program; or Competitively Employed or in Some Other Employment Calculation

Percentage =
$$[(a + b + c + d) / e] \times 100$$

= $(1,000 + 1,500 + 200 + 400 / 4,000) \times 100$
= $(3,100 / 4,000) \times 100$
= .78
= 78%
