Subject: Viewing STAAR Results in the Centralized Reporting System

To the Education Service Center and District Testing Coordinators Addressed:

The purpose of this communication is to provide you with information regarding results for the spring administration of the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR<sup>®</sup>) in the Centralized Reporting System (CRS).

As previously indicated, district testing coordinators will be able to view early student results for STAAR in CRS on May 22, 2023. As several new item types have been introduced this year, student responses for these questions are undergoing an additional review to ensure that any unique or innovative responses are not overlooked during the scoring phase. STAAR reading language arts (RLA), science, and social studies were scheduled early during the administration, so the additional review for these assessments has been completed. However, because STAAR mathematics was administered last, the additional review is still in progress.

On May 22, CRS will include raw scores, test questions, student responses, and points earned per question for STAAR RLA, science, and social studies. For STAAR mathematics, district testing personnel will be able to view only raw scores and points earned per question. On May 31, STAAR mathematics results will be updated in CRS to include test questions and student responses. An individual student's raw score for STAAR mathematics may increase as a result of the additional review, but no students' scores will decrease. Performance level information for STAAR end-of-course assessments will be included on May 31 as well.
