When will the Texas Test of Educator Proficiency (T-TEP) launch?	The Texas Test of Educator Proficiency (T-TEP) is scheduled to launch September 2027. Pending SBEC action, T-TEP would replace the Pedagogy and Professional Responsibilities (PPR) exam as the required pedagogy assessment for standard certification.	
How much does the T-TEP cost?	The price for this performance-based assessment is yet to be determined. More information will be shared with the field as it becomes available.
