How much funding will each program receive?

Funding for each program is proportional to the overall amount of candidates certified in the 2019- 2022 academic years and across the approved critical shortage areas. Therefore, funding will vary for each program. TEA staff will provide detailed information to program points of contact and certification officers. This information will include the total amount of funding available.

❖ How are candidates selected for receipt of a teacher certification exam voucher?
TEA staff does not provide teacher candidates with exam voucher codes. Programs may

determine which candidates receive an exam voucher based on many different factors. Given the variety of programs and program calendars, educator preparation programs have the discretion to decide how best to utilize their allotted funds and disseminate exam vouchers.

❖ Will an opportunity like this be offered in additional academic years?

As of now, this opportunity to receive reimbursements for exam voucher purchases is only available April-Sept. 2023.
