



# PDSES Updates: January 2025



### **Overview and Reminders**



#### The Parent-Directed Special Education Services (PDSES) program gives \$1,500 to parents of students served by special education that are enrolled in a Texas public school.



**Reminder:** The PDSES program is the same as the SSES program that began in 2021, just with a new name to better reflect the importance of parents as decision makers in the educational process.

## To be eligible for a PDSES grant, students must currently:

- be enrolled in a Texas public school,
- receive special education services through an individualized education program (IEP), and
- not have received a PDSES/SSES grant in the past.

PDSES is still a ONE TIME only grant.

### **Requirements for LEAs:**





#### As a reminder, LEAs are required to comply with 19 TAC §102.1601(j)

Requirements to provide information. School districts and open-enrollment charter schools shall notify families of the program and, unless the school district or charter school has verified that a parent has already received or applied for a program grant, shall provide the following at the student's admission, review, and dismissal (ARD) committee meeting:

- (1) instructions and resources on accessing the online accounts, including the application window established by TEA; and
- (2) information about the types of goods and services that are available through the program grant.

# provide the following at the student's admission, review, and dismissal (ARD) committee meeting:

- (1) instructions and resources on accessing the online accounts, including the application window established by TEA; and
- (2) information about the types of goods and services that are available through the program grant.



- LEAs must provide the following items to parents during their student's next or annual ARD committee meeting.
- We also recommend informing parents of eligible students prior to the application window opening – this does not satisfy the ARD requirement.

■ Each SPED director received their list of eligible students on October 25<sup>th</sup> – this is still the most updated list. This email came from TEA.



### 2024-2025 SY Application Window








### **Application Process and PDSES Parent Portal:**



### We have a new application and PDSES Parent Portal this year:


- To apply for a PDSES grant and create a PDSES Parent Portal, parents MUST create a My SPEDTex Account to be able to login.
  - Parents can create an account by going to <u>SPEDTEX.ORG</u> and click on "Create Account/Sign in".
- Once the PDSES application opens on February 3, 2025, there will be a "PDSES Parent Portal" button on the My SPEDTex Account home page after users have logged in.










PDSES One-Page Overview
