• Medicaid and Impact on Direct Certification

- TAA: <u>School Year 2024-2025 Income Eligibility Verification Forms Extension</u> Published October 17, 2024
- Due to the changes to the Medicaid participant list and its impact on Direct Certification, for the 2024-2025 school year, the Texas Education Agency (TEA) is allowing school systems to update their students' Economically Disadvantaged indicator until the PEIMS Fall Resubmission closes on **January 16, 2025**. This means that school systems can continue to try to obtain income eligibility verification forms (or other means of verifying eligibility, including the use of locally developed income verification surveys or other categorical sources of eligibility) for students past the PEIMS Fall snapshot date; however, the student must be determined to be eligible on or before October 25, 2024.
