Determine Which Graduates are College, Career, or Military Ready

Graduates are considered college, career, or military ready if they meet any of the criteria below

CCMR Criteria
Meet Texas Success Initiative (TSI) Criteria in RLA and Mathematics
Dual Course Credits
Meet Criteria on Advanced Placement (AP)/International Baccalaureate (IB) Examination
Earn an Associate Degree
Complete an OnRamps Dual Enrollment Course
Earn an Industry-Based Certification (IBC) *
Graduate with Completed Individualized Education Program (IEP) and Workforce Readiness
Graduate Under an Advanced Diploma Plan and be Identified as a Current Special Education Student
Earn a Level I or Level II Certificate
Enlist in the Armed Forces or Texas National Guard **

*A campus may not earn CCMR credit for more than 5 graduates or 20% of graduates, whichever is higher, who only meet CCMR criteria via a sunseting IBC
