

## College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) Verifier

Published May 2026

### What is the CCMR Verifier?

The CCMR Verifier is an application in [TEA Login](#) (TEAL) that enables districts to verify the accuracy of their non-TSDS PEIMS CCMR data and, if needed, submit official documentation to correct data during a specified annual window. The CCMR data shown in the Verifier is for annual graduates and non-graduating 12<sup>th</sup> graders from the **previous school year**. These data are used to determine academic accountability ratings for the current accountability year. For example, the 2026 CCMR Verifier includes the available data from the 2024-25 graduates and non-graduating 12<sup>th</sup> graders that will be reflected in 2026 accountability ratings.

### What action is required?

Districts are required to verify CCMR outcomes provided by testing vendors and outside entities for the annual graduates and non-graduating 12<sup>th</sup> graders from the previous school year. If the district does not find any discrepancies, no action is required. If discrepancies are found, districts can request data corrections through the CCMR Verifier by following the steps outlined below. These steps are specific to non-PEIMS CCMR indicators, including OnRamps; assessment results for AP, IB, SAT, ACT, and TSIA; Level I and Level II Certificates; and enlistment in the Armed Forces or National Guard. Prior to beginning the verification process, refer to the *College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) Verifier Data Requirements* document posted under the CCMR tab on the [TEA Performance Reporting Resources](#) page for important information about the requirements of the supporting documentation for non-PEIMS indicators.

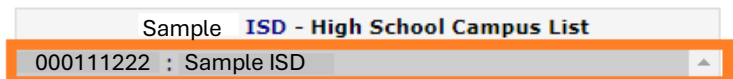
While CCMR indicators determined by TSDS PEIMS submissions are **not** eligible for corrections within the CCMR Verifier, data from the TSDS PEIMS elements are shown in the *Preliminary CCMR Student Listing* linked within the Verifier application and can be corrected through a PEIMS Working Submission, detailed below.

### Where can the CCMR Verifier be found?

The CCMR Verifier will be available in TEAL on June 4, 2026. After logging into TEAL, approved users should access the Accountability application. In the Accountability application, users can access the Verifier via the *College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) Verifier* link on the Performance Reporting tab or the What's New tab.

### How is the CCMR Verifier used?

1. Select a campus on the left side of the page:

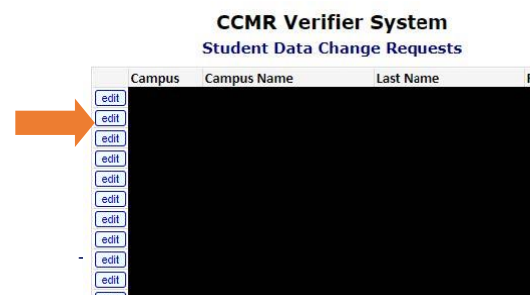


2. Sort the CCMR Met column by clicking on the column header or using the Preliminary CCMR Student Listing (Excel) link in the bottom left.

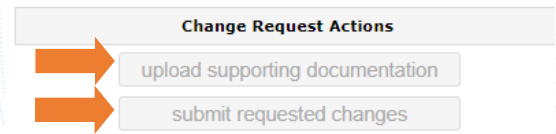

3. Click Edit to request an update to a student record.



4. Upload supporting documentation for each request using the button on the left side of the page.

5. Click Submit Requested Changes once you have uploaded **all** supporting documentation.



### Can verification requests be tracked?

TEA Performance Reporting staff will review each change request and all supporting documentation for non-PEIMS indicators. Stakeholders may check the status of each request by clicking on the *Status of Requested Changes* link in the District Resources section of the CCMR Verifier.

Within three business days, the stakeholder who submitted the request will receive an email informing them that a decision has been rendered. The message will include a link to the status page within TEAL, which includes the decision and any additional notes. If the request was rejected due to missing elements in supporting documentation, stakeholders should resubmit their request with updated materials **before the verification window closes**. It is strongly recommended that requests be submitted early to ensure any resubmissions are approved prior to the close of the Verifier. As a reminder, CCMR indicators determined by TSDS PEIMS submissions may **not** be corrected through the Verifier process. Any change requests related to TSDS PEIMS submissions should be submitted using the Working Submissions process. Following the closure of the verification window, districts may view the final decision for each change request by following the 'status' link referenced above.

### Working Submissions

During the 2025-26 school year, Working Submissions correcting errors from the 2023-24, 2024-25, and 2025-26 PEIMS Submissions can be submitted for use in CCMR calculations beginning with 2026 accountability. CCMR indicators informed by PEIMS data will be included in the CCMR Verifier in the *Preliminary CCMR Student Listing*. However, the 2025 Grad and Non-Grad tabs in the CCMR Tracker, Part I, were included to support the timely completion of Working Submissions, and indicators informed by PEIMS are an exact match to what will be in the CCMR Verifier. Districts are encouraged to leverage the CCMR Tracker, Part I, released in April 2026, to determine whether a PEIMS Working Submission is needed due to errors reflected in projected accountability data.

Data from Working Submissions submitted prior to September 11, 2025, including those submitted as part of the 2025 appeals process, will be reflected in the CCMR Tracker, Parts I and II, and in the CCMR Verifier. Data from Working Submissions submitted prior to September 11, 2025, including those submitted as part of the 2025 appeals process, will be reflected in the CCMR Tracker, Parts I and II, and in the CCMR Verifier. Working Submission data submitted after September 11, 2025, will not be included in the CCMR Tracker or the CCMR Verifier, but may be considered for 2026 accountability ratings.

**While a Working Submission can be submitted for any data errors, only those related to CCMR indicators will be considered for accountability ratings in 2026 and subsequent years.**

**These indicators include:**

- College Prep Course Completion
- Dual Credit completions
- Industry-Based Certification (IBCs)
- Program of Study Completer elements
- Associate Degree attainment
- Diploma Type values for reported graduates with completed IEP and workforce readiness
- Diploma Type and endorsement values for reported graduates earning an advanced diploma and who were served within Special Education Programs

*Working Submissions to correct errors from 2023-24 and 2024-25 PEIMS submissions do not apply retroactively to prior years of accountability ratings.*

All PEIMS Working Submissions must be processed, as indicated via email from TSDS PEIMS, by June 26, 2026, to be included in 2026 accountability ratings calculations. **It is strongly recommended that school systems initiate the Working Submission process by June 12, 2026, to ensure inclusion in 2026 preliminary ratings. Working Submissions initiated after June 12, 2026, may not be processed in time for 2026 accountability ratings if incomplete or incorrect.**

If the data submitted via Working Submission can be used in preliminary accountability ratings, there will be an additional request made of the superintendent or their designee to communicate the school system's understanding of which accountability year(s), domain(s), and component(s) will be affected by the updated data submitted.
