






Student Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity






With both the PEIMS Student Demographic Listing and TIDE open, you may want to ask yourself...

-  Is the first name, last name, date of birth, and TSDS ID correct and consistent for every student? (PEIMS ID # is optional)
-  Are any students who have enrolled since snapshot accurately reflected in TIDE?
-  If a student's demographic information has changed since the Fall PEIMS Submission, is that update reflected in TIDE?



Ensuring Data Accuracy in TIDE

The Test Information Distribution Engine (TIDE) is the vendor system used to manage user and student information



Corrections made after the window will not be reflected in final administration reports.

Scenario

Using the PEIMS Student Demographic Listing, a school discovers that a student's first and last name are different in TIDE.

In the listing: Katherine Jubert
In TIDE: Katie Joubert

Can the LEA correct in TIDE?

YES!

The student's name can be corrected in TIDE and should match what has been submitted via PEIMS.

When: Name corrections can be before or during the test administration window or during the data verification window.

Will it impact accountability ratings?

YES!

The first name, last name, date of birth, and TSDS number should match between PEIMS and TIDE. Otherwise, there is a risk that the student data will not sync and this "new student," Katie Joubert would not be included in the accountability subset.

Scenario

A new student enrolled in January and is not reflected in the PEIMS Student Demographic Listing or TIDE.

Can the LEA correct in TIDE?

YES!

The student should be entered into TIDE and assessed in any applicable subject areas for their grade level.

When: Corrections can be made before or during the test administration window.

Will it impact accountability ratings?

No!

This student was not enrolled in the campus during the Fall PEIMS Submission, and their results will not be calculated as part of the 2026 accountability ratings.

Scenario

A student was exited from Special Education services on February 5th, 2026.

Both TIDE and the PEIMS Student Demographic Listing have this student listed as SPED.

Can the LEA correct in TIDE?

YES!

The student information should be corrected in TIDE as non-SPED, since they were exited prior to the testing window.

When: Corrections can be made before or during the test administration window.

Will it impact accountability ratings?

YES!

As this student is no longer receiving special education services, they would not be included in the High Focus group in Domain 3 (assuming none of the other criteria were met) for STAAR based indicators.

If the student was also a graduating senior, they would be included in the High Focus group for School Quality and Grad Rate in 2027 ratings

Scenario

An LEA uncovers, using the PEIMS Student Demographic Listing, that all of their economically disadvantaged students were incorrectly coded in the PEIMS Fall Snapshot as non eco-dis

Eco Dis % in PEIMS and TIDE:
0%
Actual Eco Dis %: 78%

Can the LEA correct in TIDE?

YES!

Each individual student's information can be corrected in TIDE.

When: Corrections can be made before or during the test administration window.

Will it impact accountability ratings?

YES, and No

The corrected information will be used to determine individual students who are in the High Focus group for STAAR indicators

The campus's data submitted in the Fall PEIMS Submission will be used in relative performance calculations



Ensuring Data Accuracy for CCMR

LEAs have an opportunity to correct prior year PEIMS submissions, specific to CCMR data, to be used in accountability ratings

House Bill 8 - Accountability Implications

College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR)

- Prior-year CCMR indicator data: Similar to how a current-year CCMR data submission update opportunity is provided by TEA for accountability with the CCMR Verifier, TEA must provide a process for the submission of prior-year CCMR data for accountability purposes.



- Reminder: Updates in TIDE are critical, but are not used for CCMR calculations
- Demographic data used in accountability calculations for CCMR cannot be updated
- Other data for CCMR can be corrected through a Working Submissions and must be accepted by PEIMS on or before June 26, 2026
