School Health Survey 2024-2025

The Texas Education Code (TEC), §38.0141, requires the Texas Education Agency (TEA) to collect data relating to student health and physical activity from each school district/charter district. The School Health Survey has been developed for this purpose. The data gathered will allow the agency to better address the various health-related needs of Texas schools and students statewide.

The survey will take approximately 15-30 minutes to complete. This survey must be **completed online** and can be **submitted only once** for each school district (including a district designated as a district of innovation) and open-enrollment charter school. Responses should reflect the entire 2024-2025 academic year and may require input from different staff members within the district/charter school to completely answer the survey questions.

Please coordinate with staff to ensure there is **one submission** per school district/open-enrollment charter completed on a single device. Should a school district or open-enrollment charter submit the survey more than once, the most recent submission, even if incomplete, will be considered the final submission.
