Texas COVID Learning Acceleration Supports (TCLAS) is a set of targeted supports and <u>additional</u> state and federal funding aligned to the Learning Acceleration Framework.

LEAs will access TCLAS funding and supports through a single, streamlined discretionary, non-competitive grant application that mimics the simplicity of a formula grant.

- ➤ No narrative responses required
- No need for grant writers
- Easy budget calculations

High-quality, sustainable teacher residency planning and implementation support in partnership with an Educator Preparation Program.



Grant funding for teacher resident stipends and access to strategic staffing design and implementation supports.

#### **Grow Your Own**

Pathways for High School
Students



\$8,000 - \$10,000 per high school | \$5,000 - \$10,000

per Education and Training teacher

Pathways for Paraprofessionals



\$7,500 - \$18,000 tuition reimbursement per candidate



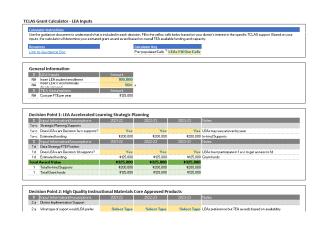

 decisions made in TCLAS


